 - 2.1. **Repetition** – Words or phrases that repeat.
 - 2.2. **Contrasts** – Ideas, individuals, or items that are contrasted with each other.
 - 2.3. **Comparisons** – Similarities between ideas, individuals, or items.
 - 2.4. **Lists** – Instances where more than two items are mentioned together.
 - 2.5. **Cause and Effect** – Causes and their resulting effects.
 - 2.6. **Figures of Speech** – Expressions in a non-literal sense.
 - 2.7. **Conjunctions** – Connecting words (and, but, for) and their connection.
 - 2.8. **Verbs** – and their tense.
 - 2.9. **Pronouns** – Pronouns and their antecedents.
