^{relational} This is the message we have heard from him

message - verbal or written
communication received
heard - we know it is verbal

^{conjunction} and declare to you: God is light;

the one who spoke the message (Jesus)
we - John and others

Announce officially
(in him there is no darkness at all.)

God's holiness and source of truth

Goal: Pure & truthful FOS
say we do
if we claim to have fellowship with him

Walk in darkness does not accept God
or chooses not to obey

All who have Fellowship w/him Relationship
(and yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live out the truth.)

Contract: state of living in sin

Photocopy this page from Matthew 28:18-20 and make as many observations as you can on this passage. Follow the format presented in the example of Romans 12:1-2.

Then Jesus came to them and said, ^{what Jesus did} disciples ^{who it is that came to them}

- Jesus was given complete authority in heaven (divine) and on earth

"All authority in heaven and on earth all power & control"

where the authority is present

has been given to me. ^{already done} came from someone else

The disciples were to make disciples

The disciples were to baptize others by Jesus' authority

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, ^{to teach & train others}

The disciples would go to all nations - this would be people who have other gods & worship them

baptizing them in the name of the Father ^{Head of the family}

The disciples were to teach and convince them about the one true God and the Son

to be cleansed from the old self to a new self w/ Christ and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. ^{Jesus} also ^{the power of God}

Repeated I - Jesus

and teaching them to obey ^{the commandments & laws}

Jesus states he will be with the disciples always to the end and must teach what he has commanded.

everything I have commanded you ^{All fathers} told you ^{the disciples}

And surely I am with you always, ^{Jesus} ^{disciples} ^{never leaving constant} to the very end of the age. ^{the best moment}

The disciples are under Christ's authority

The disciples are to travel sharing the gospel everywhere
